I want to make this clear. Since you are using MY copyrighted data you are required to do what I say regarding these issues, or remove everything from your site that contains my collection of data. Content theft is a crime.

This is not meant as a personal attack. I have to respond this way to anyone who doesn't comply with my requests to make changes that impact the tone of the game. There are many reasons why I have to protect my copyright, and many reasons why lost caches need to be removed from your site.
